House of Love: A Ripple Effect

Meet Do, a shining example of the ripple effect that Brittany's Hope partnerships can have. This young woman has a bright future by any standard: she is an accomplished college graduate, a successful music teacher, a community leader, a wife, and young mother. But as a child, she was destined for a life of poverty.

Far up in the hillside of Viet Nam, Do's mother toiled each day scavenging for food. They had no land of their own to farm and the physical limitations of Do's father left him incapable of taking care of his family. Do was born into an illiterate ethnic family of eight children, leaving this smart, talented girl very few opportunities to prosper.

Do's mother, unable to care for her young children, made the heartwrenching decision to send Do and her two younger sisters to live away from home so they could get the care and nutrition they needed. But when Do arrived at the House of Love Orphanage, it too was struggling with financial difficulties.

During that time, the House of Love Sisters regularly knocked on neighbors' doors to beg for rice for the children in their care.

They had all their love to give to the children, but little of anything else.

That all changed with a chance encounter that lead to a partnership with Brittany's Hope.



Our partnerships give children the chance to be what they need to be: kids. The children in our orphanages attend school and gain their voices as independent, confident individuals. They receive proper nutrition and healthcare. No longer distracted by rumbling stomachs or untreated illnesses, many excel in their classes and enjoy their childhood as they should.

Not only are the individual children empowered, but families are as well. Through income-generating partnerships sponsored by Brittany's Hope, many children can stay where they belong: with their families and enrolled in school. No longer do parents need to make the agonizing choice between keeping a starving child at home—or sending the child away for a better life.

Blooming like the fruit trees at the House of Love, our programs have changed the lives of many—but there is much more to do. Do's early childhood before the House of Love isn't unique; many children every day are starving and searching for clean water, suffering from curable childhood diseases, laboring in fields, and dreaming of the chance to go to school.

It's so easy to feel overwhelmed thinking about the needs of these children, but remember—change can begin with you. You can make a difference with just one child: a child who is given love, nourishment, education, and the biggest gift of all: hope.


