House of Love Expansion

The House of Love orphanage in Viet Nam is special to Brittany's Hope. Throughout our 10 year relationship, we have been blessed to watch a group of saddened children blossom into a happy and loving family. It was a long and bumpy road, but our strong partnership has ensured each child's safety and wellbeing.

The center's location made it susceptible to natural disasters, like typhoons which placed its buildings under 2 feet of water. While these disasters didn't endanger the lives of the children, it made the center's overpopulation apparent. Nearly 100 people would crowd into small rooms on the second floor of the original, antiquated building. It

was clearly time to expand and compensate for nature.

In January 2012, Brittany's Hope finished an incredible expansion to the House of Love center. This new building is elevated, spacious and functional! With the help of our supporters, we were able to supply new classrooms, a sustainable fruit garden, a library and most importantly a comfortable bed and locker for each child to call their own. In addition, the original buildings were repaired and upgraded! It was such an accomplishment that over 600 people from around the country, including government officials, joined the kids and their caretakers in an opening celebration.

When Brittany's Hope traveled to Viet Nam to attend the center's grand opening, an invitation was extended to sponsors and supporters. During their journey, the group visited orphanages in Ben Tre, Da Nang and Ho Chi Minh City where they implemented projects and distributed essential items to orphaned children.

The highlight of the trip was a visit to the House of Love where many of the group members sponsor a child. There is often a pre-conceived notion that their involvement in their sponsored child's life will be limited to a monthly contribution. We believe that the connection forged through sponsorship is special and encourage our sponsors to send gifts, exchange letters and hopefully one day visit the child that they love and nurture from far away.

Viet Nam has been one of the primary focuses of the Humanitarian Aid that Brittany's Hope provides. When adoptions

from the country ceased, it was even more important that resources be allocated to caring for the children who would remain in orphanages, without necessities or hope. Each year, we provide safe cribs, bikes, infant formula, vitamins, food, clean water and education to hundreds of kids through centers that span the unusual length of the Viet Nam

countryside. We couldn't possibly sustain our programs abroad without the generous commitment of our supporters who provide monetary support to children who live thousands of miles away.

My name is Vo Thi Thanh Hang and I am a recent graduate of the Da Nang Red Cross Vocational Embroidery class sponsored by Brittany's Hope. The two year class went by quickly, but it has left a deep impression on me. The instructors were kind and considerate to their students, and were genuinely concerned about our success. I considered the center a second home as it was an exciting place

to live, learn and work in one comfortable environment.

The center often organized activities, games and interactions with volunteer students which were helpful for our overall moral. I remember quivering as I held my first needle, thinking I might not be able to do this job, but the teachers were great at keeping me encouraged.

I continuously felt thankful to Brittany's Hope and my instructors for supporting and inspiring me. I knew that I had to try my best and because of that, I finally have experience and a skill in a field that I truly enjoy.

I no longer reside at the center because the program helped me to locate a suitable embroidery job. I receive products from Tam Ky and embroider them at home. My income is great as it allows me the independence I've always dreamed of but often considered unreachable. I no longer feel self-pity and shy as I did before. I now feel joyful, happy and marketable. It is amazing to believe that a

special needs child (hearing impaired & nonverbal) like me has been able to find a stable job. With the money that I am earning, I can easily support myself.

I will focus on the future and promise to do a great job to make the most of the education I have been blessed with.
